

Child Behaviour Policy

Children under 13 are to be supervised at all times.

This policy is in place for your comfort and safety and for the enjoyment of others. The Clubhouse is not a playground and we would ask that it is treated with respect.

We ask that you children **do not**:

- Stand on or climb on the furniture and window ledges
- Run around the Clubhouse, on the stairs or in the changing rooms
- Shout across the Clubhouse
- Deface or remove notices from display boards
- Throw things

We also ask that children are seated whilst eating to avoid unnecessary mess. We understand that accidents may occur and ask that you draw the attention of a member of staff to any spillages so that they can be cleaned straight away.

The Club **will not** condone the following:

- Anti-social behaviour
- Persistent swearing
- Throwing of rackets or other items
- Wilful or careless damage to the Club premises or property

Anyone found in breach of the above may risk being barred from the Club. The following procedure will be followed:

- The incident should be reported to a Coach, Member of Staff or Committee member.
- An incident report will be filed with name(s), date(s) and details of the incident. The Safeguarding Officer will be made aware if appropriate.
- If the incident involves a junior member/guest, their parent or guardian will be notified.
- A member of the Committee may then contact the person concerned to discuss the incident and take any action that may be required.

Serious infringements or a repetition of bad behaviour may lead to a temporary or permanent ban.
